SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION & REQUIREMENTS

The Building Officials Association of Texas has a strong desire to advance the visibility and importance of building safety throughout the construction industry while also assisting students who have a sincere interest in continuing their education. Scholarships are provided directly to each recipient to assist with tuition, fees, equipment, and other school related expenses. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$2,000, as determined by the BOAT Executive Board each year.

Requirements:

Scholarship applicants must be a graduating high school senior or currently enrolled in an accredited university, college, trade school, or apprenticeship program. Applicants must also be a dependent of a BOAT member or BOAT member organization. Field of studies related or relevant to construction, architecture, engineering, materials science, fire protection, or safety will be given preference. Dependents of the BOAT Scholarship Committee are not eligible. Applications will be considered along the following criteria:

- Financial need
- GPA as provided by the school/program
- The applicant's field of study
- Civic and personal achievements
- Recommendations
- How the scholarship will benefit the applicant
- Presentation of application, the committee's assessment of the applicant's character, consideration for documented learning, extraordinary achievements, and other factors the committee feels deserve considering.

Applications shall be made by **June 15, 2026**, and shall include (2) Letters of Recommendation, and transcripts with GPA scores. The BOAT Scholarship Committee will carefully consider each application and award the scholarship during the BOAT Annual Conference.

In addition to the question responses, each application submittal must include at least (2) Letters of Recommendation as well as school transcripts with GPA scores.

Describe any civic or personal achievements, or extracurricular activities, that demonstrate good character.

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Describe any special hobbies or interest you have.

Tell us about yourself and why the Committee should consider you for the BOAT Scholarship?

What is the name of the building official for the city where you reside?

What types of building codes, and code cycle (year), has the city you live in adopted?
